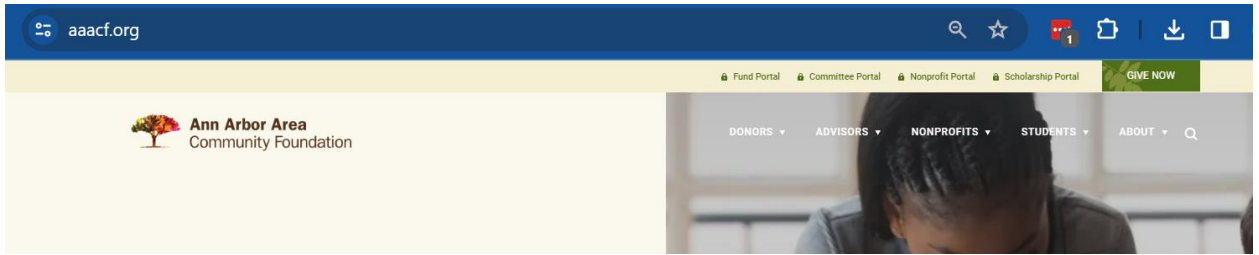
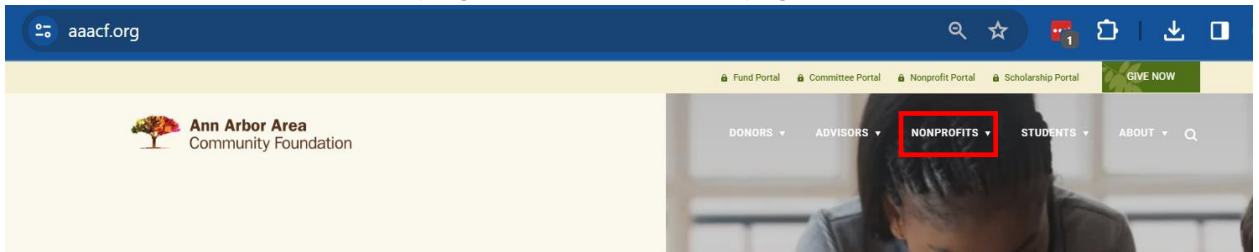

1. Visit www.aaacf.org

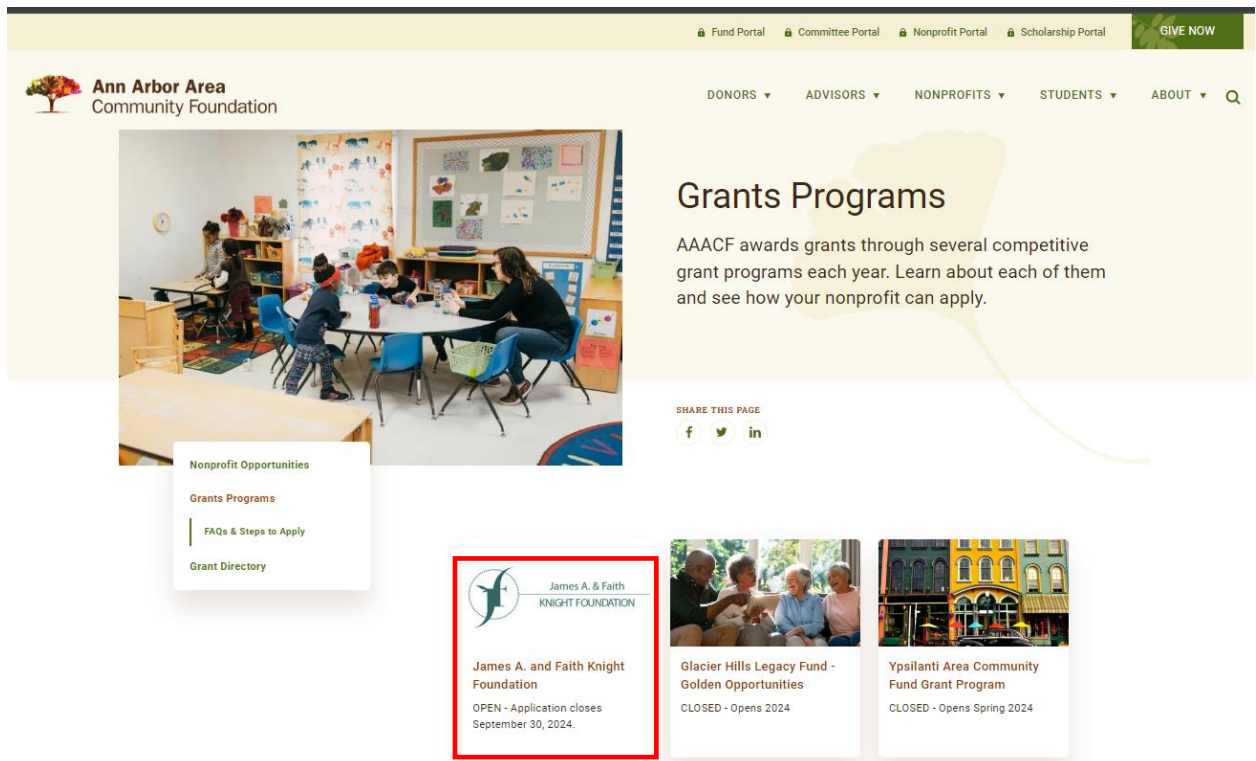


2. Click on “NONPROFITS” in the top right-hand corner of the page.
